When it comes to avoiding fraud, Kansas Gas Service wants you to know the facts. Individuals may call, email or come to your door and falsely claim to work for Kansas Gas Service or other local utilities and services in an attempt to steal your private information. By learning how to recognize these imposters, you can help prevent fraud from happening to you.




You should be aware that if your Kansas Gas Service account is current, no one from our company will call you and ask for personal financial information.* You may always access your account information by logging in to your account at www.kansasgasservice.com or by calling us at 1-800-794-4780.

Be wary of giving personal information over the phone or through email. Never provide your Social Security Number, credit card number or banking information to anyone requesting it over the phone or at your home unless you initiated the contact and feel confident with whom you are speaking. If you receive a suspicious call, hang up and call Kansas Gas Service to verify that the call was authentic. You may also report the incident to your local law enforcement agency.

Kansas Gas Service employees will enter your home only if you have contacted us for service, if we are responding to an emergency or if we are re-establishing service after it has been interrupted. Our employees always carry company IDs, which they will be happy to show you. If you have any concern about the legitimacy of someone claiming to work on behalf of Kansas Gas Service, please call us at 1-800-794-4780 and press 0 to speak with a customer service representative.

New Rates for Kansas Gas Service Customers Approved by the Kansas Corporation Commission

On November 29, 2016, the Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC) approved a base rate increase for Kansas Gas Service. The new rates apply to natural gas service rendered on and after January 1, 2017.

RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS: The average residential customer will experience a monthly increase in rates of \$1.25, or \$15 per year. Customers will see fixed charges increase from \$16.11 to \$16.70 per month. The delivery charge will increase by approximately \$0.105 per thousand cubic feet (Mcf).

GENERAL SALES CUSTOMERS: The customer charge for General Service Small, Large and Transport Eligible customers will remain the same. The delivery charge for customers served in these rate classes will increase \$0.22, \$0.10 and \$0.07 per Mcf, respectively. Additionally, the minimum volume threshold necessary to qualify to become a transport customer has decreased from 1,500 Mcf per year to 800 Mcf per year.

This rate increase does not reflect the cost incurred by Kansas Gas Service to purchase natural gas and to obtain delivery and storage of natural gas from interstate pipelines. The price of natural gas is not regulated and is subject to market forces, such as supply and demand, storage capacity and weather.
