DON'T FALL FOR THE CALL!



Individuals may call, email or come to your door and falsely claim to work for Kansas Gas Service or other local utilities and services to try to steal your private information. Follow these tips to avoid utility scams:

- BE WARY OF GIVING PERSONAL INFORMATION OVER THE PHONE OR THROUGH EMAIL. Never provide your Social Security Number, credit card number or banking information to anyone requesting it over the phone, by email or at your home unless you initiated the contact and feel confident with whom you are speaking.
- DO YOUR RESEARCH. If you receive a call from someone claiming to be from your utility company and feel pressured for immediate payment or personal information, hang up the phone and call the customer service number on your utility bill. You may also report the incident to your local law enforcement agency. Be aware, if your Kansas Gas Service account is current, no one from our company will call you and ask for personal financial information.*
- BEWARE OF THE DOOR-TO-DOOR SALES APPROACH. Never allow anyone into your home to check electrical wiring, natural gas pipes or appliances unless you scheduled an appointment or reported a utility problem. Kansas Gas Service employees will enter your home only if you have contacted us for service, if we are responding to an emergency or if we are re-establishing service after it has been interrupted.
- ALWAYS ASK UTILITY EMPLOYEES FOR PROPER IDENTIFICATION. Our employees and contractors always carry. company IDs, which they will be happy to show you. If you have any concern about the legitimacy of someone claiming to work on behalf of Kansas Gas Service, please call us at 1-800-794-4780 and press 0 after the tone to speak with a customer service representative, or contact your local law enforcement agency.
- BE PROACTIVE. If you already have provided information to someone claiming represent your utility, contact your bank immediately. Also contact the three national credit bureaus – Equifax, Experian and TransUnion – and request a notation made on your account so that it doesn't impact your credit rating.
- INFORM OTHERS. Share this information with friends and family so they do not become victims of utility fraud.
