Contact 811 Before You Dig

Spring is here, and that can mean it's time to head outside for some outdoor projects you've been putting off all winter. If any of those projects involve digging, there's an important call you need to make first before you dig: **a call to 811.**

April is National Safe Digging Month and the perfect time to refresh your knowledge about safe digging practices. To prevent injury, damage and service outages, it's important that all underground utility lines be identified before any digging project begins.

One phone call to 811 will alert owners of registered pipelines, telecommunication cables and power lines to mark their buried utilities within two full working days of the request. **There's no charge to you for this service.**

You may also submit a request online by visiting **kansas811.org**. Whether you're planting a tree or shrub, tilling soil, installing a deck or setting fence posts, always remember to call 811 at least two full working days, before you plan to dig to allow utility line locations to be marked. It's easy to do!

During National Safe Digging Month, and any time of year, be safe and contact 811 before you dig.
